




IHE-Europe



- IHE-Europe is still streamlining it's governance model in line with the statutes for setting up a legal entity by the beginning of April
- IHE-Europe consists of 10 IHE national initiatives:
 - Austria, France, Germany, Israel, Italy, Norway, Spain, Sweden, The Netherlands, United Kingdom
- IHE-Europe has the responsibility of
 - The contact with the European Commission
 - The organization of the European Connect-a-thon
 - The development towards Europe
 - The recruitment of the European User and Vendor associations

Activities

 The main activity of IHE-EUR is the organization of the yearly connectathon (test of interoperability between vendors during 5 days)
